Low Cost - No Need To Buy

Lease As Long As You Like

With this plan there is no additional charge for exchanging to a larger instrument as your child grows. (For example: if you change from a 1/2 size violin to a 3/4 size violin, the monthly lease fee stays the same.) When your child is ready for a full-size instrument, you may apply 100%** of your accumulated lease credit toward the purchase of a new instrument or customized outfit.

Our Objective is to help you and your child select an instrument that will best fit his/her musical needs and your pocketbook. Our knowledgeable musical instrument sales people are ready to answer your questions.

Maintenance & Repair Coverage (M & R)

This plan offered by ECKROTH MUSIC provides parents and students with a service agreement which covers maintenance service by our qualified repair technicians. This service includes all strings, adjustments and repairs needed to keep the instrument in excellent playing condition including any accidental damage.

- M & R coverage for violins and violas is \$5.45 per month and is added to your payment each month.
- M & R coverage for celli is \$6.45 per month and is added to your payment each month.
- M & R coverage for basses is \$7.95 per month and is added to your payment each month.

Your Leased Instrument May Be Returned To The Store At Any Time

In this event your child does not continue to play, simply return the instrument to ECKROTH MUSIC and your lease payments automatically cease.

Oliolin Unaltered for centuries, the violin is perhaps the most widely recognized orchestral instrument. Whether you call it a violin or a fiddle, it is the string family's soprano or highest voice. High pitched, beautifully toned, the violin is often used as a lead or solo instrument, particularly in music demanding fast passage work.

Oliola Played in much the same manner as the violin, the viola is slightly larger and tuned differently than the violin. A larger tone chamber endows the viola with its mellow qualities and enables it to produce sombre, moody tones. The alto voice of the string family, the viola adds depth and richness and is vital for string ensembles and quartets.

represents the tenor voice of the string section. Tuned a full octave lower than the viola, the cello produces deep lower registers and subdued higher tones.

Unlike either the violin or the viola, the cello is supported on the floor by an endpin while the seated performer steadies the instrument with their knees.

In the double bass, or string bass, is the largest and lowest instrument of the string family. The double bass has rounded shoulders instead of square shoulders like other string instruments. Because of its size, the player stands or sits on a high stool to play it. The double bass plays a wide assortment of music, from Classical to Broadway to Jazz. Like the violin, viola, and cello, it is plucked or drawn with the use of a bow.
